



**POSTDOC SCHOLAR EMPLOYEE POSITION IN
NUCLEAR AND RADIOCHEMISTRY**



A Postdoctoral Scholar position will be available in the Department of Chemistry, University of California, Berkeley, for a recent Ph.D. with experience in nuclear and radiochemistry, radiation detection techniques, separations chemistry or closely related field. Experience with actinide/lanthanide chemistry and glove box handling technique is desirable. Candidate should be able to obtain controlled access to U.S. DOE National labs.

The project is funded by the National Nuclear Security Administration and will involve research on the separation of radioactive isotopes, preparation of targets for neutron capture experiments and data analysis. The successful applicant will work closely with scientists from Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory (LBNL) and Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL).

This appointment starts January 1, 2012, or earlier, and is for one year, with possibility for renewal thereafter, depending on availability of funding. Annual salary range is \$54,826 to \$58,116, depending on experience and qualifications.
